Equity – Ensuring fair and just access to immunizations for all, prioritizing vulnerable and underserved populations.

Inclusivity – Respecting diverse beliefs, cultures, and needs while promoting public health.

Safety – Upholding a commitment to safe and effective vaccination practices at all levels.

Trust – Building and maintaining trust through transparency, reliability, and meaningful community connections.
